	Boys' Uniform	Girls' Uniform
Shirts	Regular Days: All grades, short or long sleeved white school polo shirt with school logo Gym Days: Alhuda Academy green T-shirt (short or long sleeved)	Regular Days: Grades 2 and below, short or long sleeved white plain school polo shirt. Grades 3 and up, long sleeved white plain school polo shirt. Gym Days: Alhuda Academy green T-shirt. Grades 3 and up girls must have oversized gym shirts that cover their hips and are long sleeved.
Pants/ Jumpers	Regular Days: Khaki school pants (pleats, pull-on or flat seams). No cargo pants or other styles permitted. Gym Days: Plain black sweatpants with no designs	Regular Days: Khaki school jumper with school logo for grades KG-5. Khaki school jumpers should be knee-length. Khaki school pants (pleats, pull-on or flat seams) under jumper: Grades 2 and up. No cargo pants or other styles permitted Gym Days: Plain black sweatpants with no designs
Abayas/ Hljabs	N/A	Regular Days: Middle school girls must wear plain black abayas (no designs such as frills are allowed) on non gym days. Hijabs are a must: Grades 5 and up girls are required to wear a plain white instant hijab at all times, long enough to cover them. Grades KG -4 are required to have a white instant hijab with them for salah.



Shoes/ Socks	Shoes: Dress shoes or sneakers are allowed. Shoes should be solid black, brown, gray, or white (no designs). No bright colored shoelaces allowed. Shoes should also be closed toe-shoes only, no sandals. Sneakers must be worn on gym days. Socks: solid white, black, or gray socks (only) must be worn at all times.	Shoes: Dress shoes or sneakers are allowed. Shoes should be solid black, brown, gray, or white (no designs). No bright colored shoelaces allowed. Shoes should also be flat closed toe-shoes only, no sandals, no high heels or platform shoes or boots. Socks: solid white, gray, or black socks/stockings/leggings (only) must be worn at all times. PreK-KG: must wear long white stockings/leggings under jumper, if not wearing pants.
Sweater/Cardigan	The school spirit hunter green sweater/cardigan with school logo is permissible and may be worn over school uniform. No hoodies are allowed.	The school spirit hunter green sweater/cardigan with school logo is permissible and may be worn over school uniform. No hoodies are allowed.

Please Note:

- No jewelry or wristbands and no makeup including tinted lip balms. Fingernails should be kept clean (no nail polish) and neatly trimmed.
- Hair should always be cut, not long, and neatly combed and pulled back of the face for all male students.
- Hair: PreK to Grade 4 girls must tie back hair in a ponytail, braids, headband, or hair clips.
- Grades 5 and up girls must wear a plain white instant hijab (no designs) that is long enough to cover them at all times during school hours and school functions including extra-curricular, after-school and weekend activities, clubs and school study-groups. No loose hijabs allowed.
- Students need to always have clean and pressed clothes. Students are not allowed to wear jackets and coats in the classrooms, only school sweaters. No torn or ripped clothes are permitted. Students not abiding by the uniform policy will be given 2 verbal warnings followed by a phone call and written note to parents per Quarter. Afterward, students not wearing proper uniforms will not be allowed in the classroom. Students wearing Islamically improper clothes will not be allowed in the classroom and parents will be called right away.
